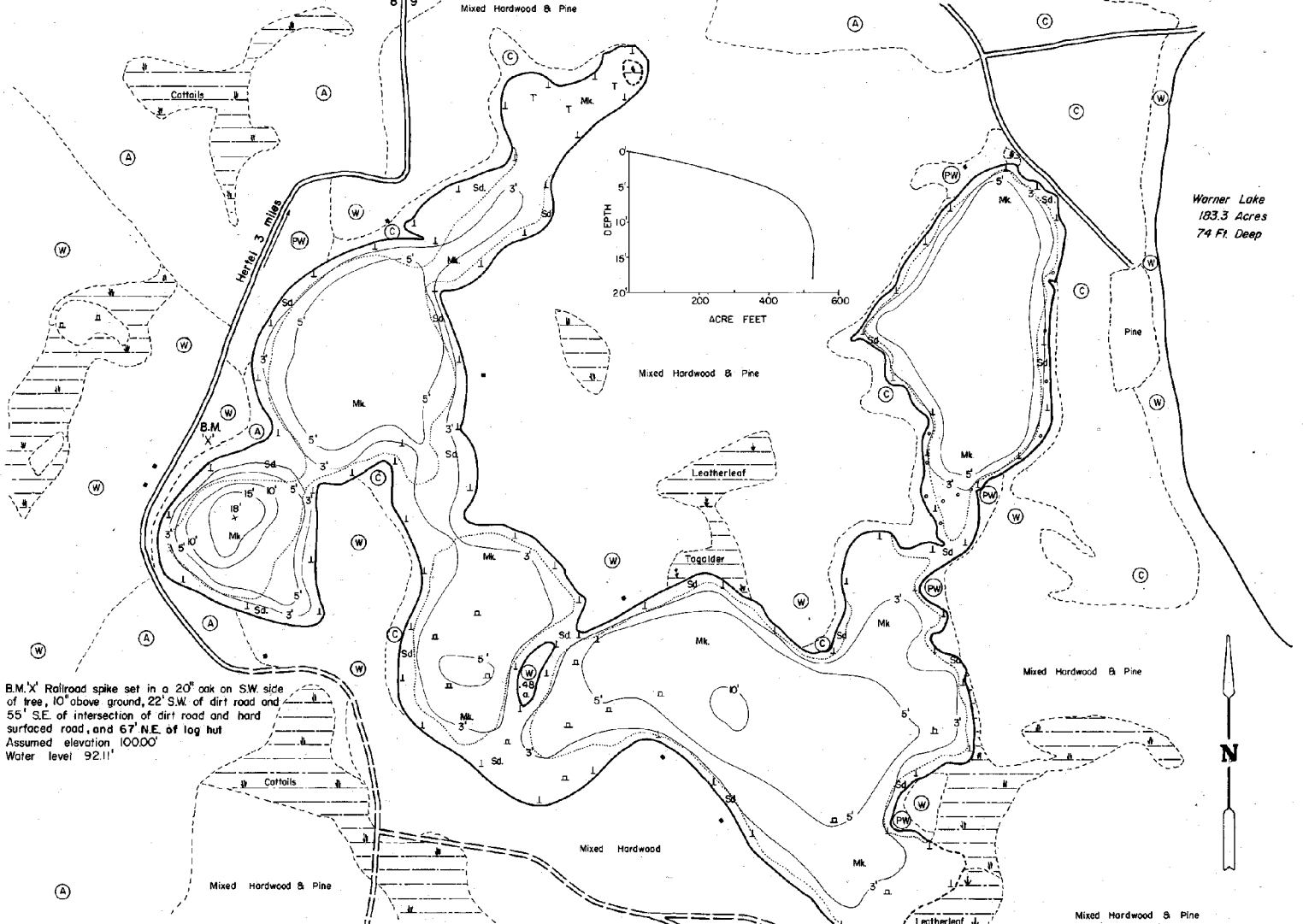

LAKE SURVEY MAP

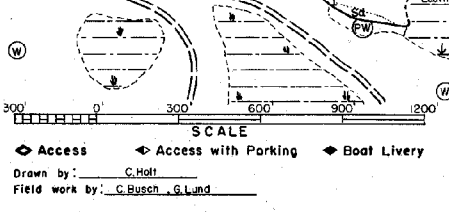
