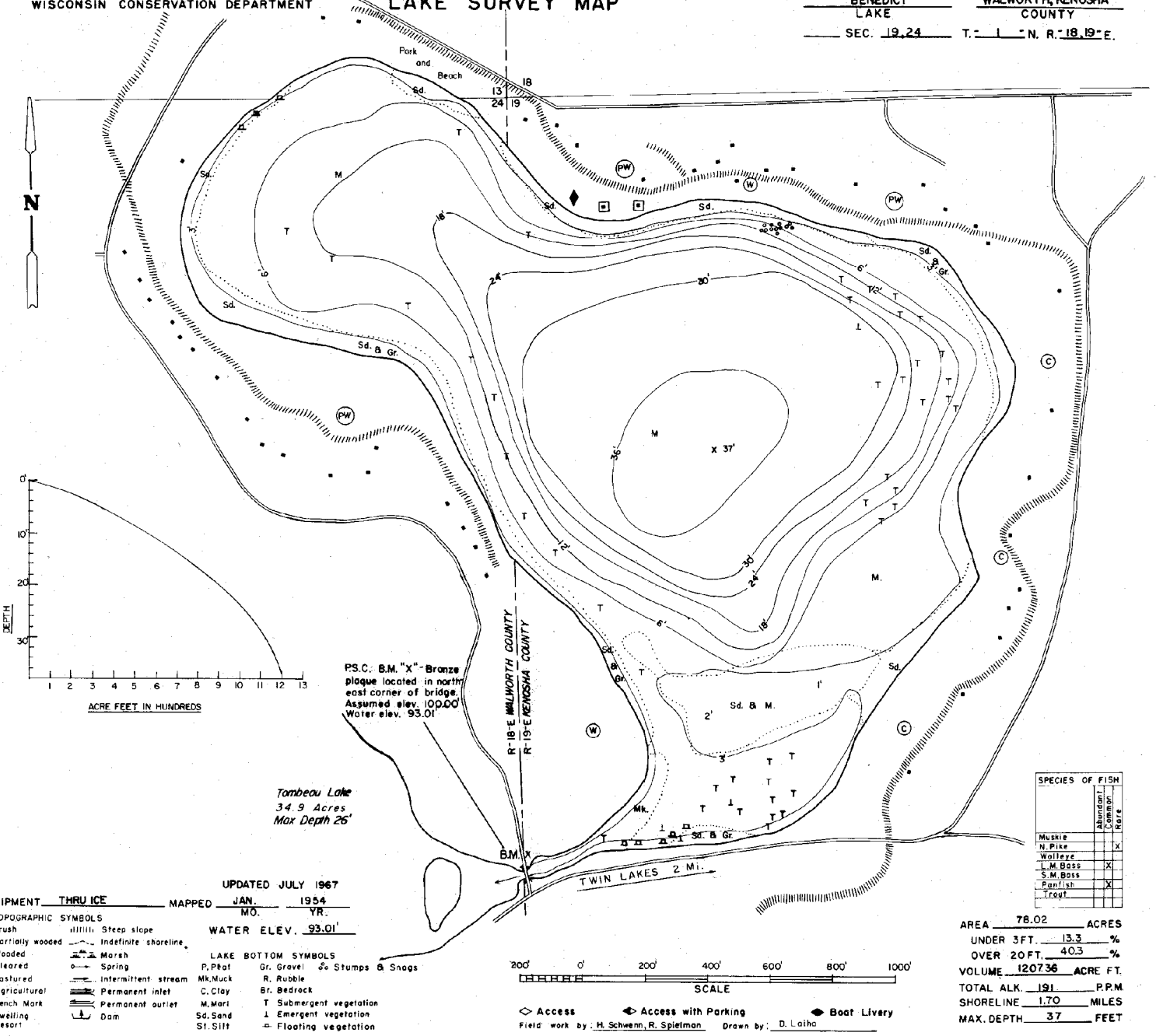
LAKE SURVEY MAP
