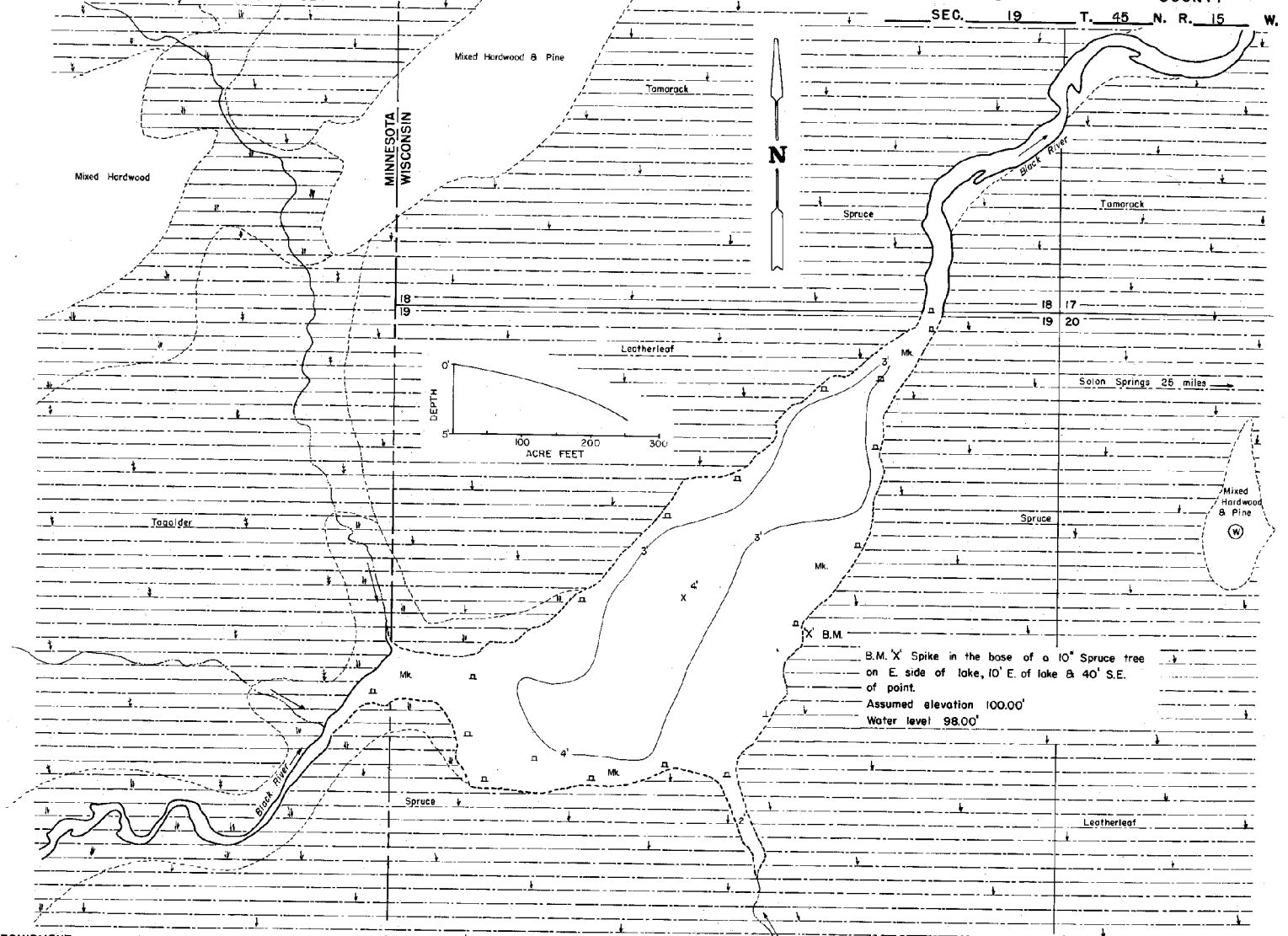

SEC. 19 T. 45 N. R. 15 W.

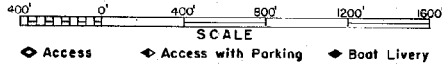


B.M. X Spike in the base of a 10" Spruce tree on E. side of lake, 10' E. of lake & 40' S.E. of point.
