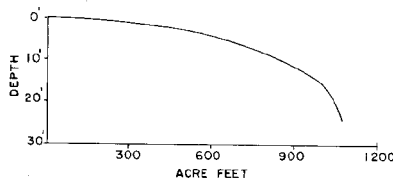
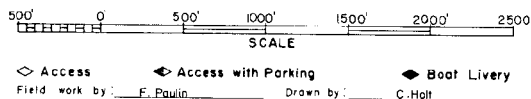


B.M. 'X' S.E. corner top of W. concrete walk of bath house, Salvation Army Camp
