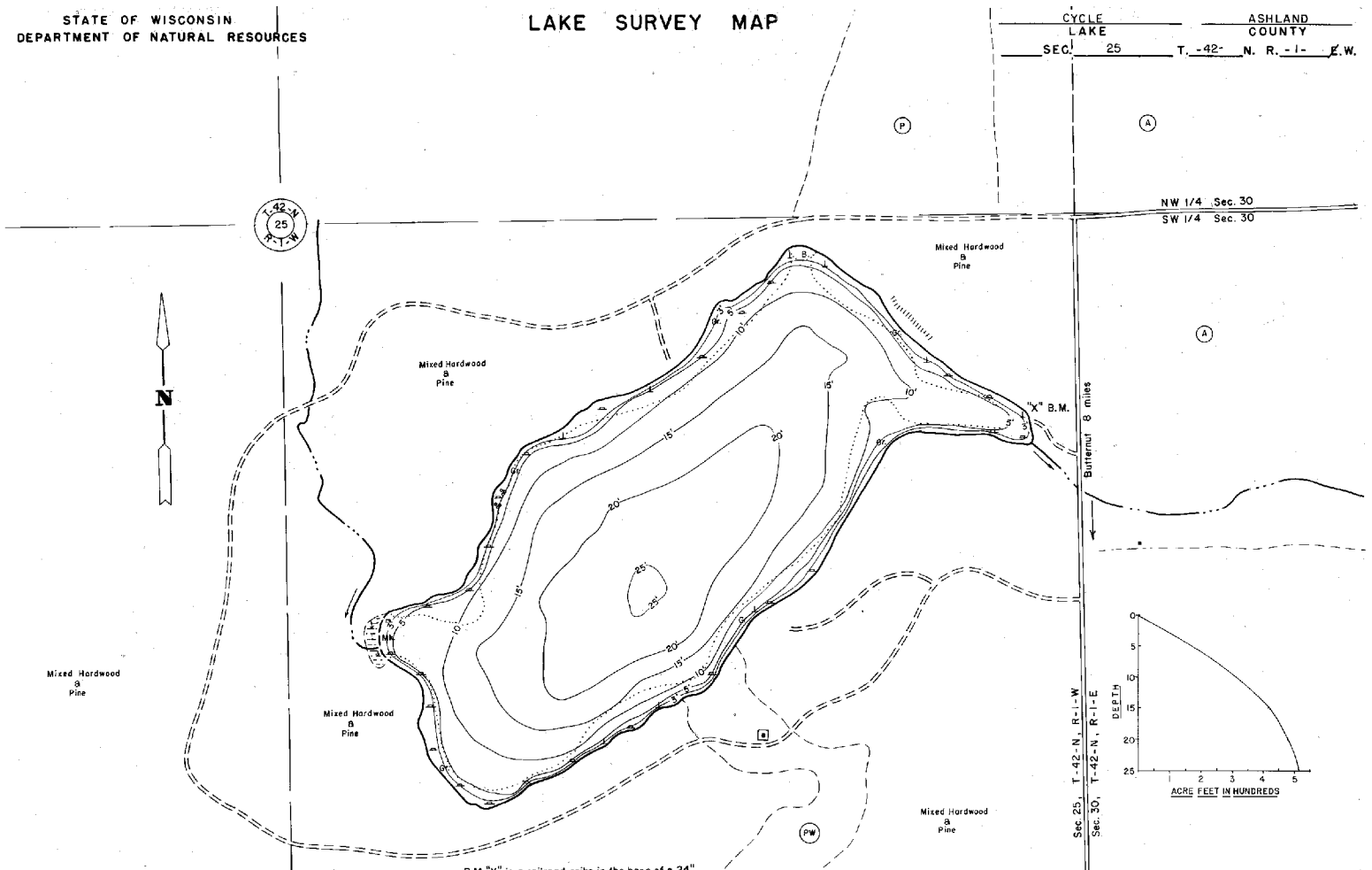

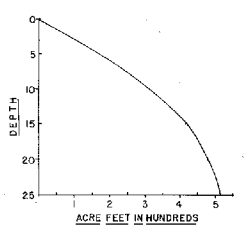
LAKE SURVEY MAP

SEC. 25 T. -42- N. R. -1- E.W.



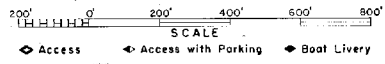
