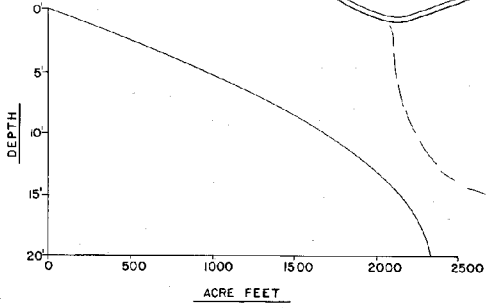
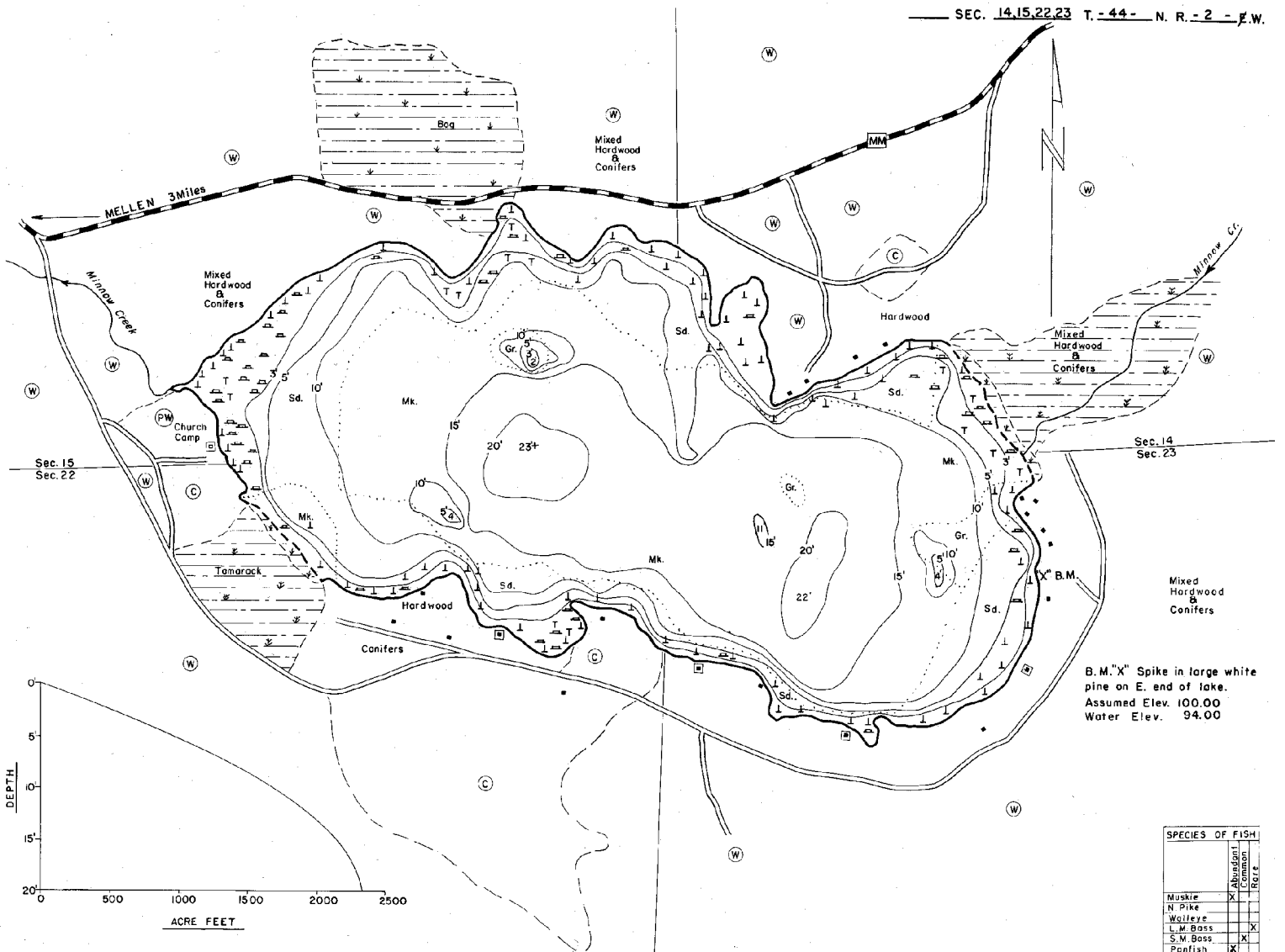

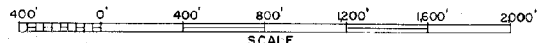


B.M. "X" Spike in large white pine on E. end of lake. Assumed Elev. 100.00 Water Elev. 94.00
