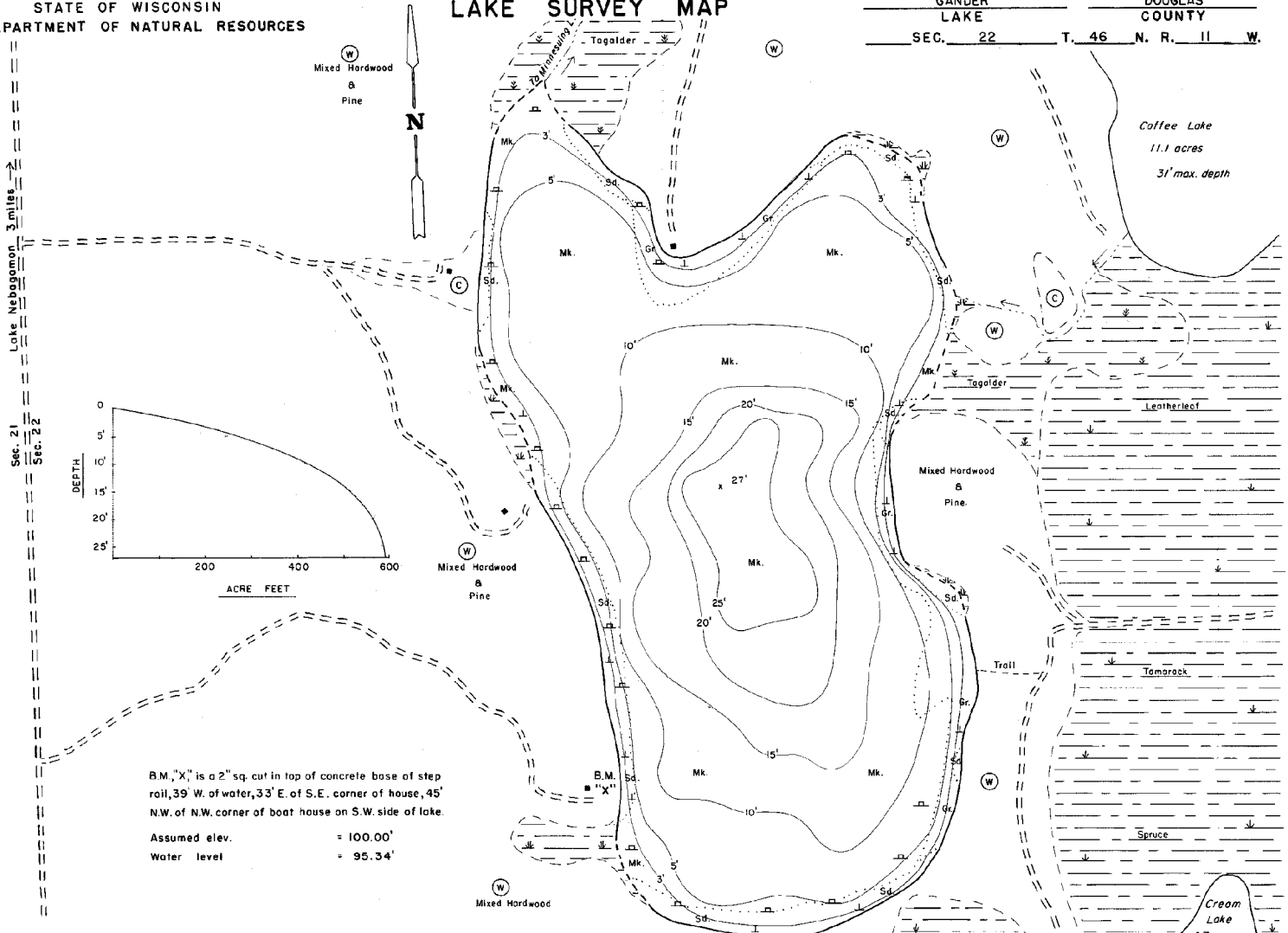

SEC. 22 T. 46 N. R. 11 W.

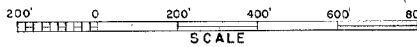
