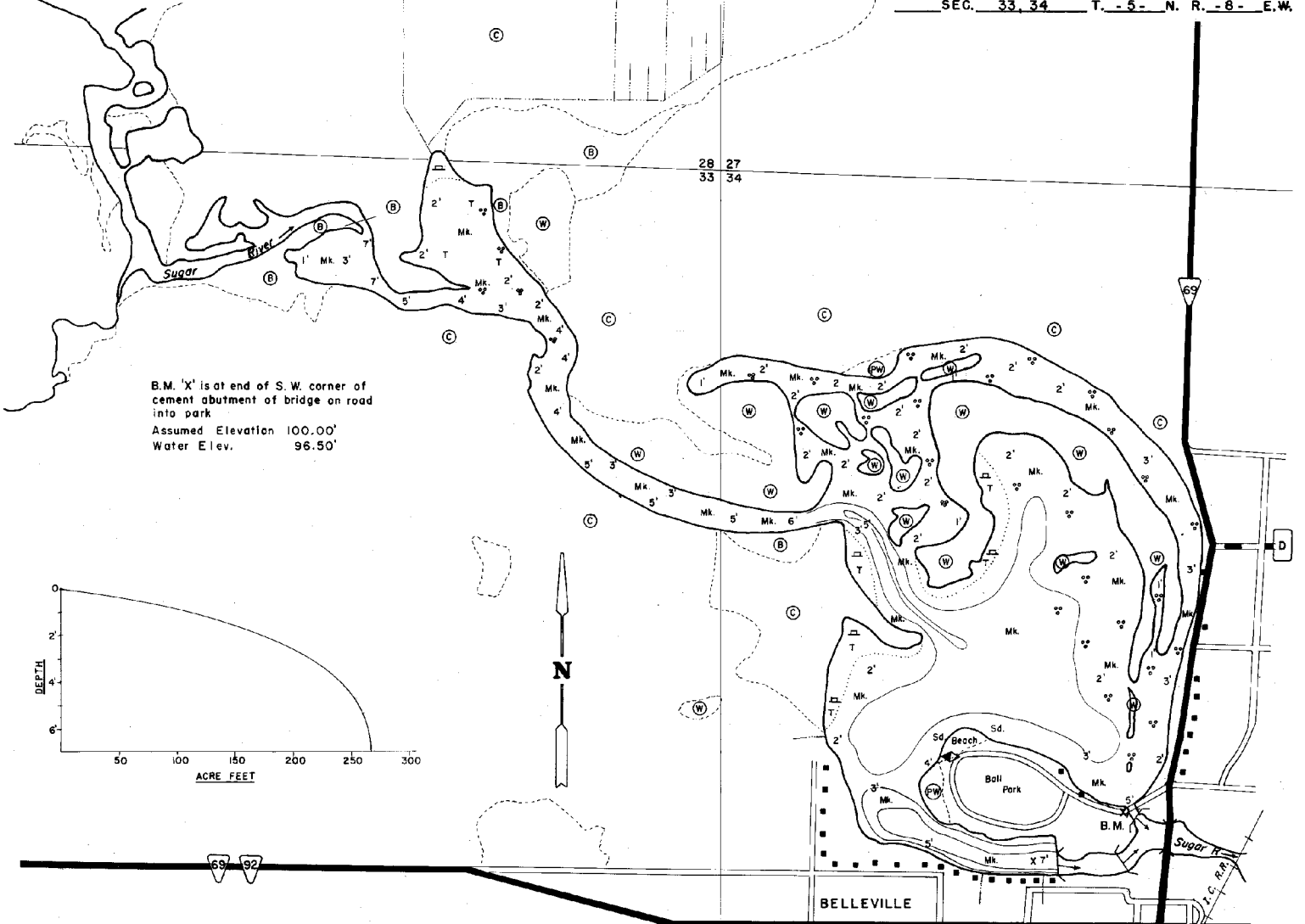


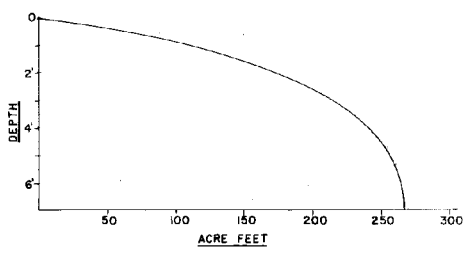

LAKE SURVEY MAP

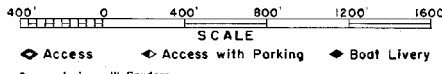
