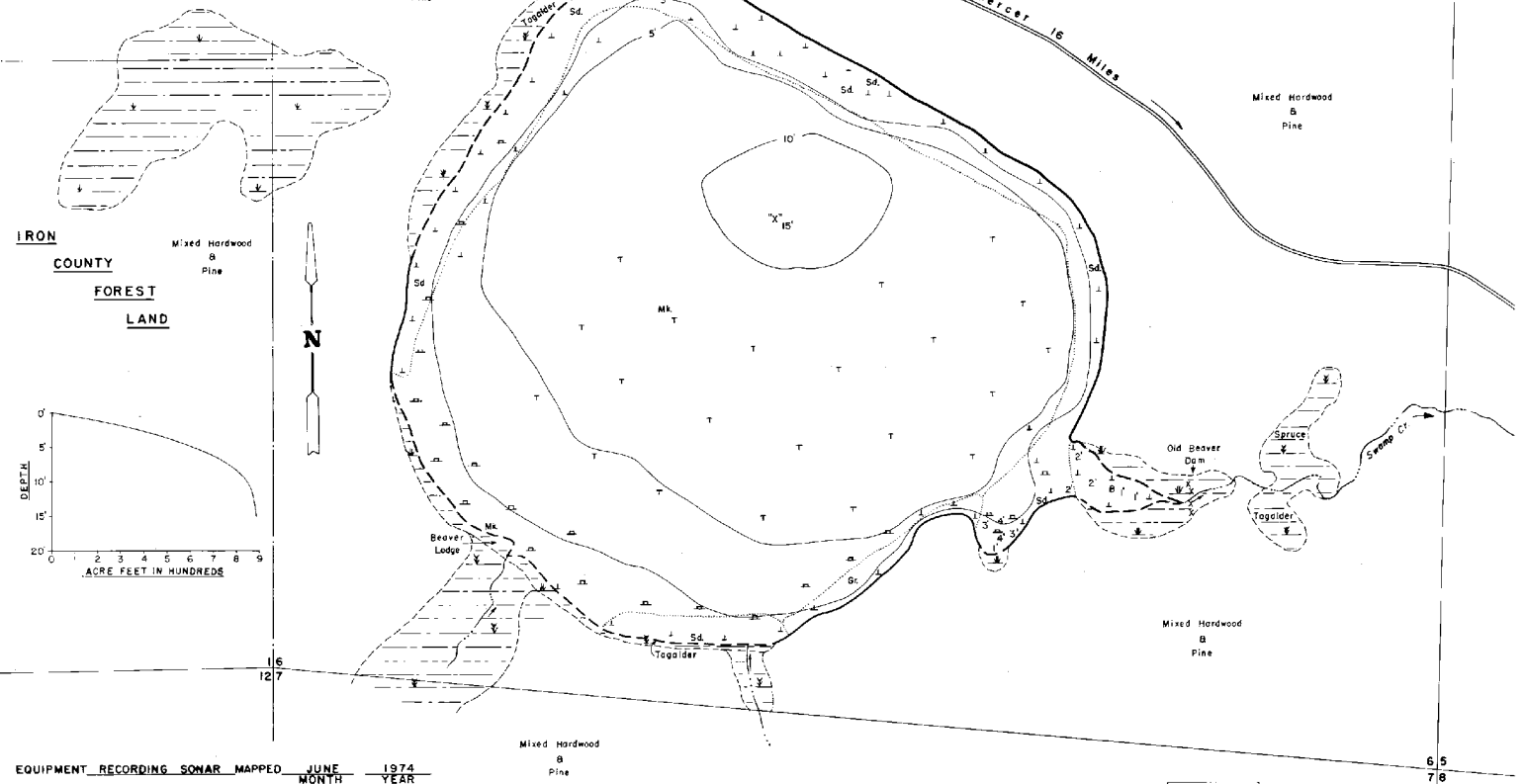

Assumed Elevation = 100.00'
Water level = 94.93'
