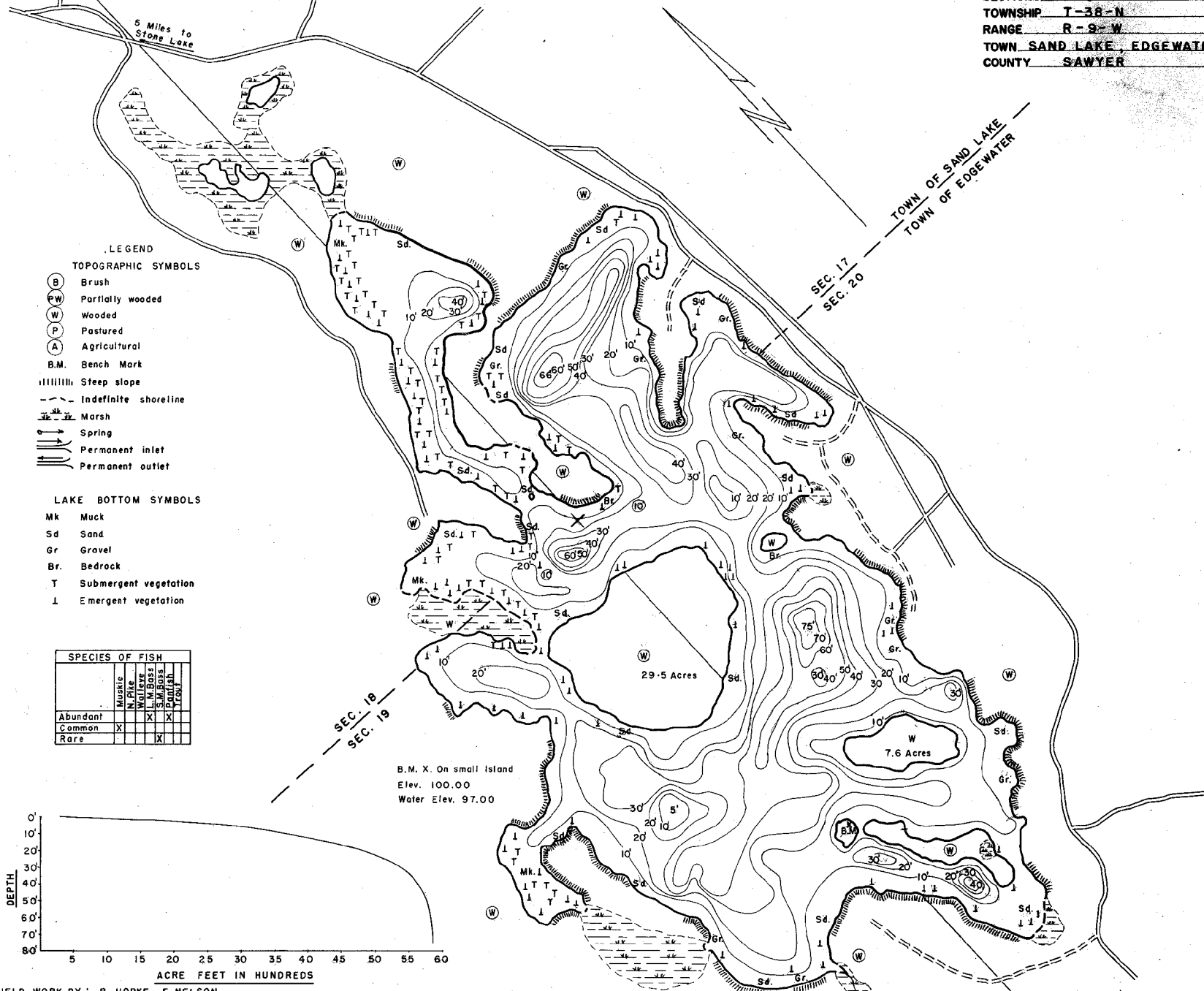

LAKE SURVEY MAP

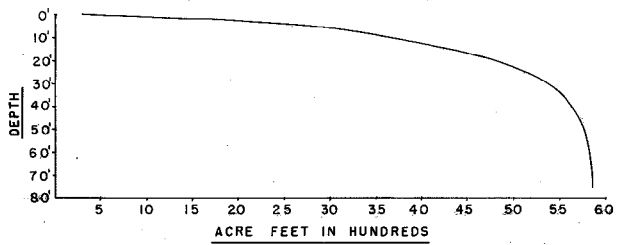

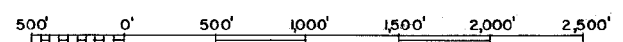
