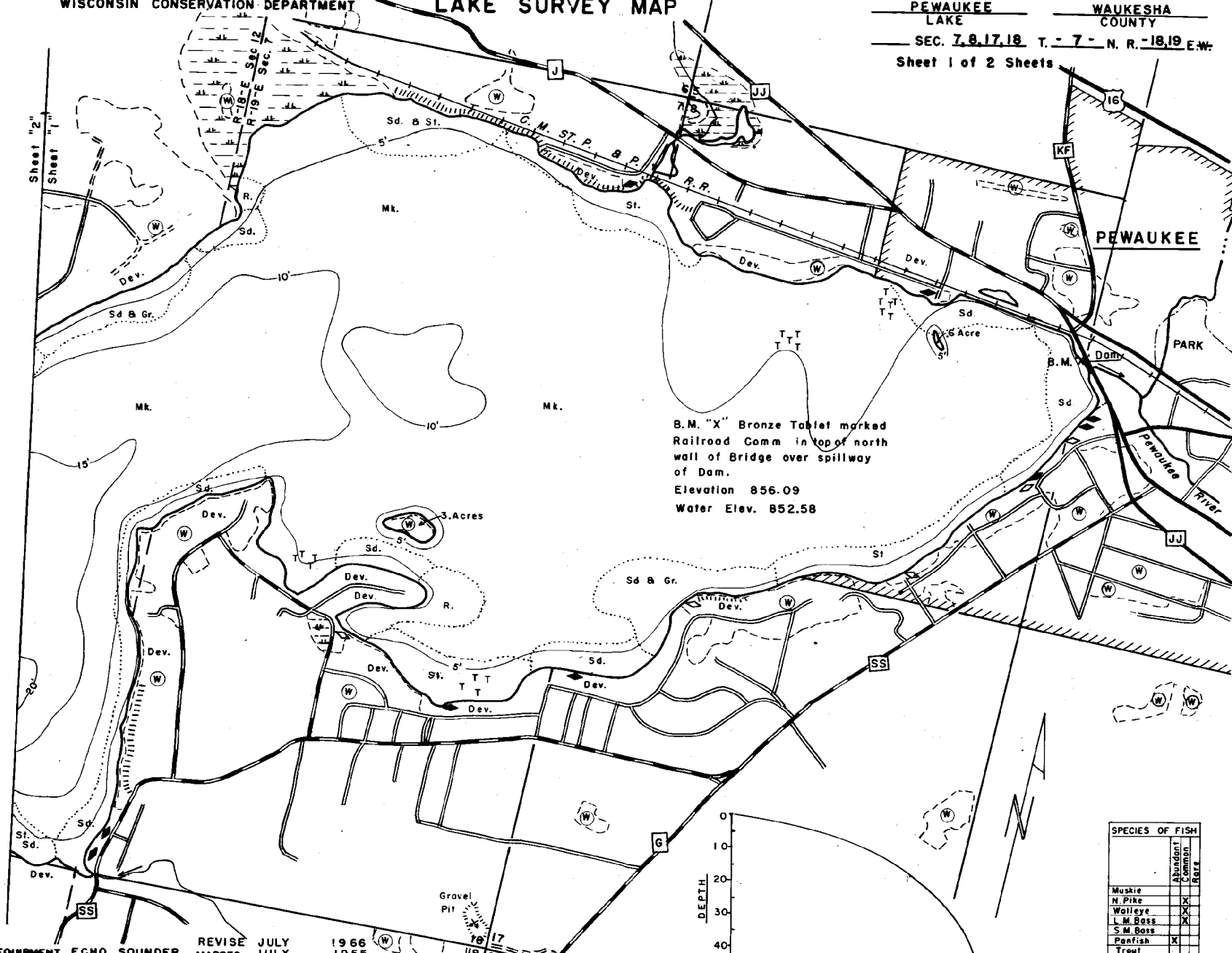
LAKE SURVEY MAP

PEWAUKEE LAKE

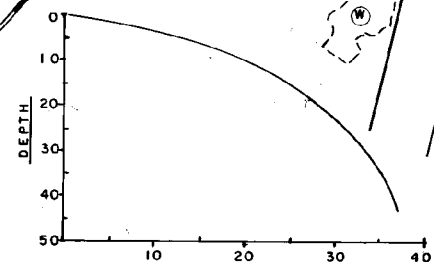
