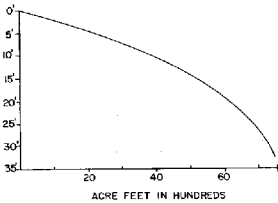

 SEC. 13, 18 T. 1 N. R. 18, 19 E.



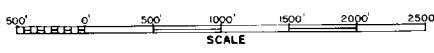
B.M. 'X' Chisled square in center of E. side of bridge outlet on Powers lake road (C.T.H. FF¹)
