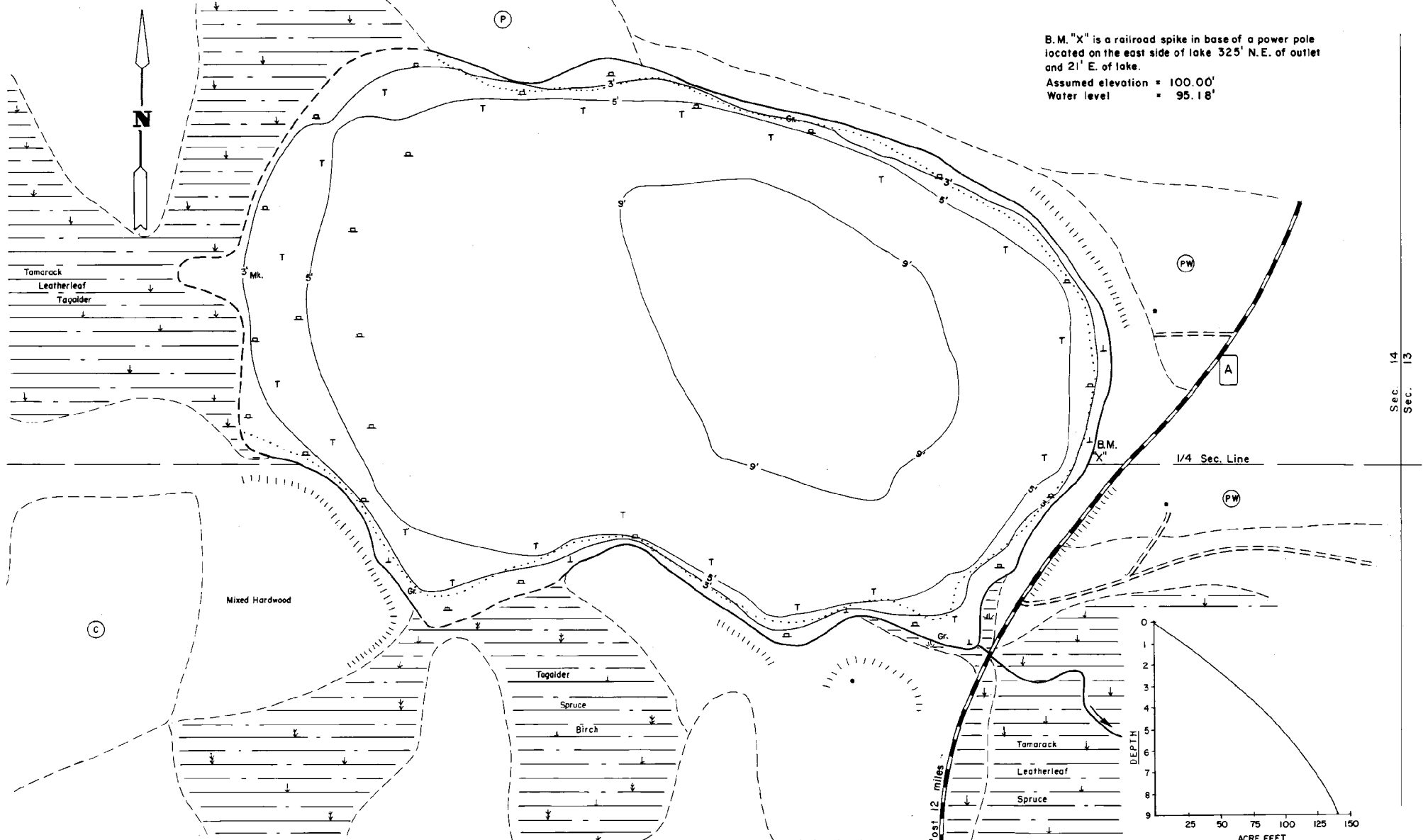

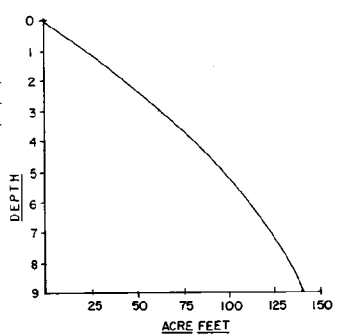
LAKE SURVEY MAP

Water level = 95.18'

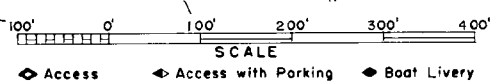
