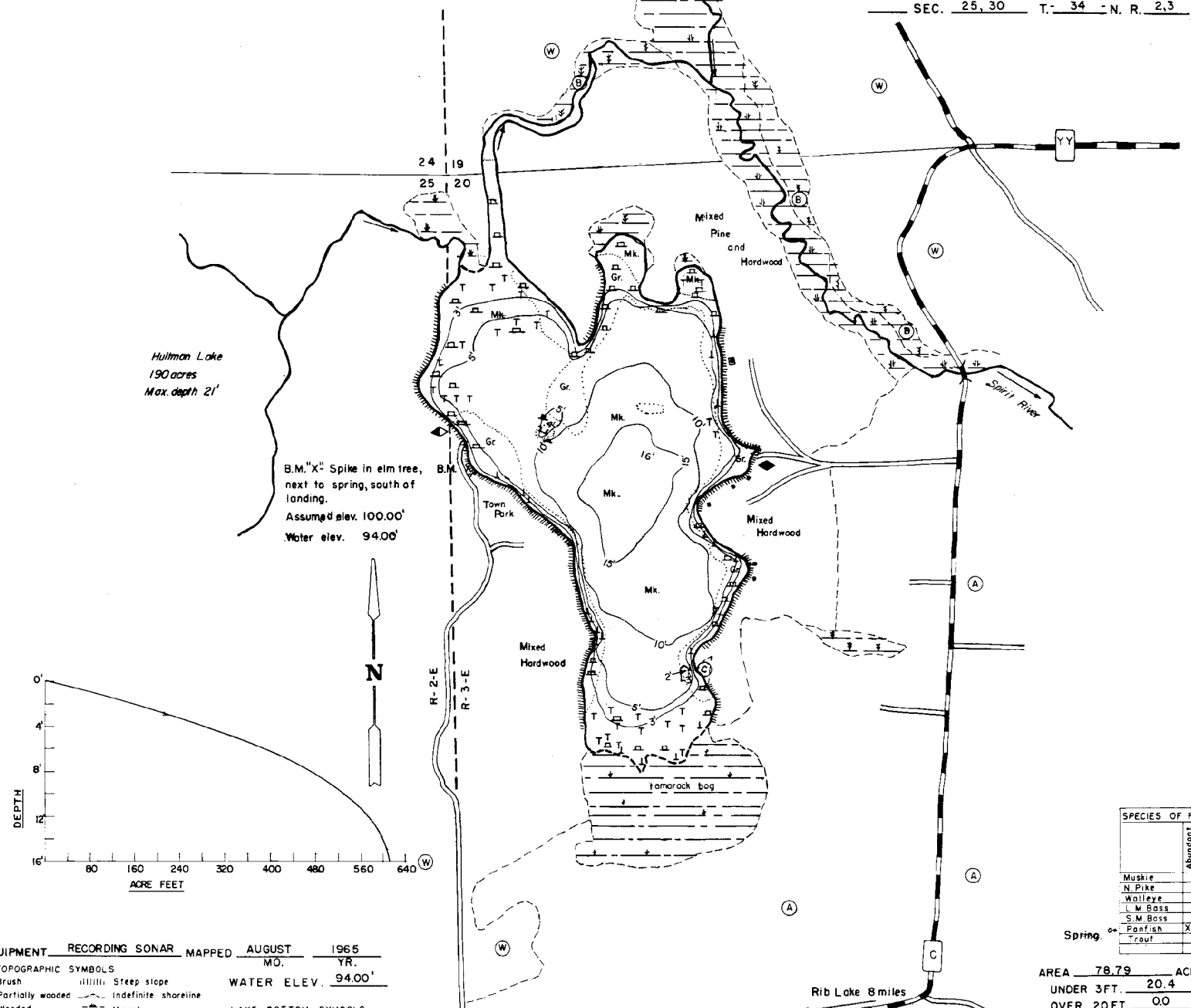


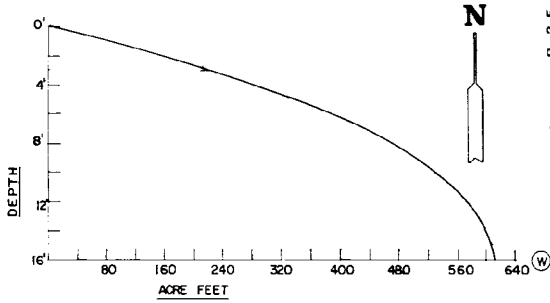

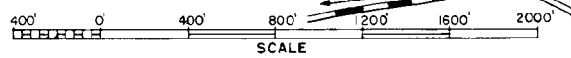


B.M. "X" Spike in elm tree, next to spring, south of landing.
