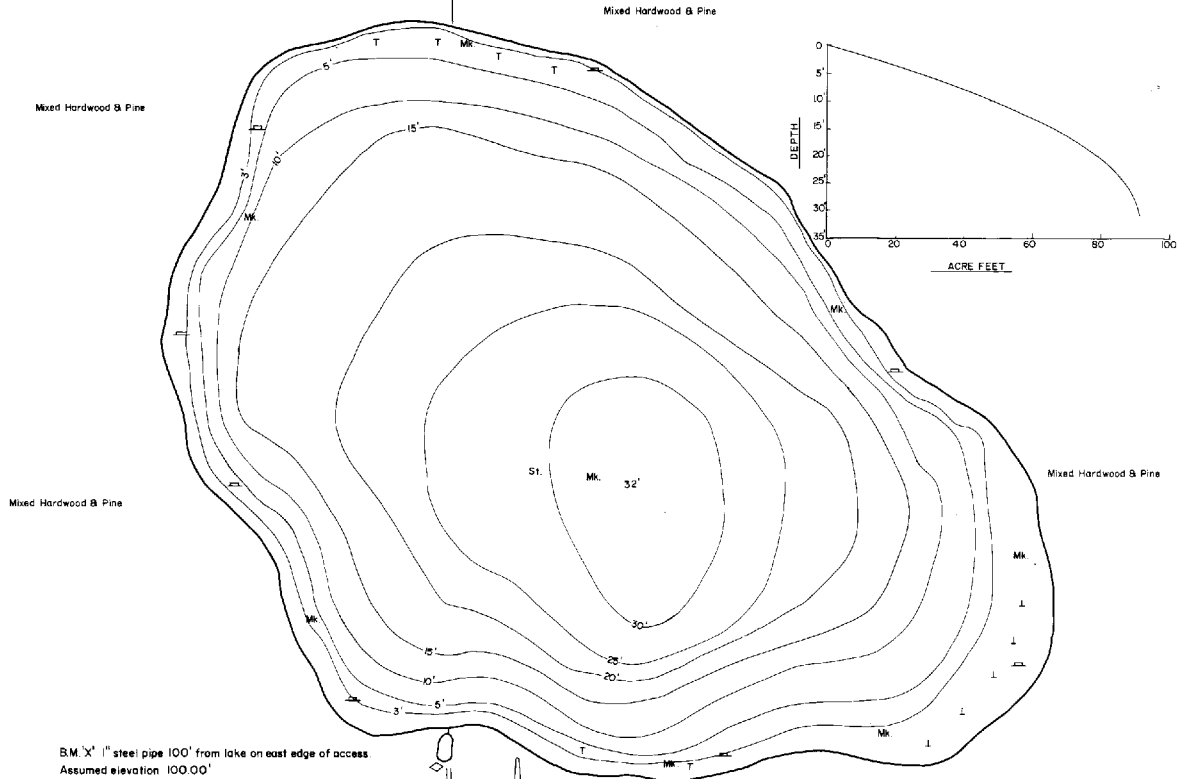

SEC. 10 T. 18 N. R. 23 E.

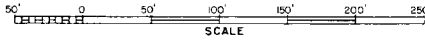


B.M. 'X' 1" steel pipe 100' from lake on east edge of access.
