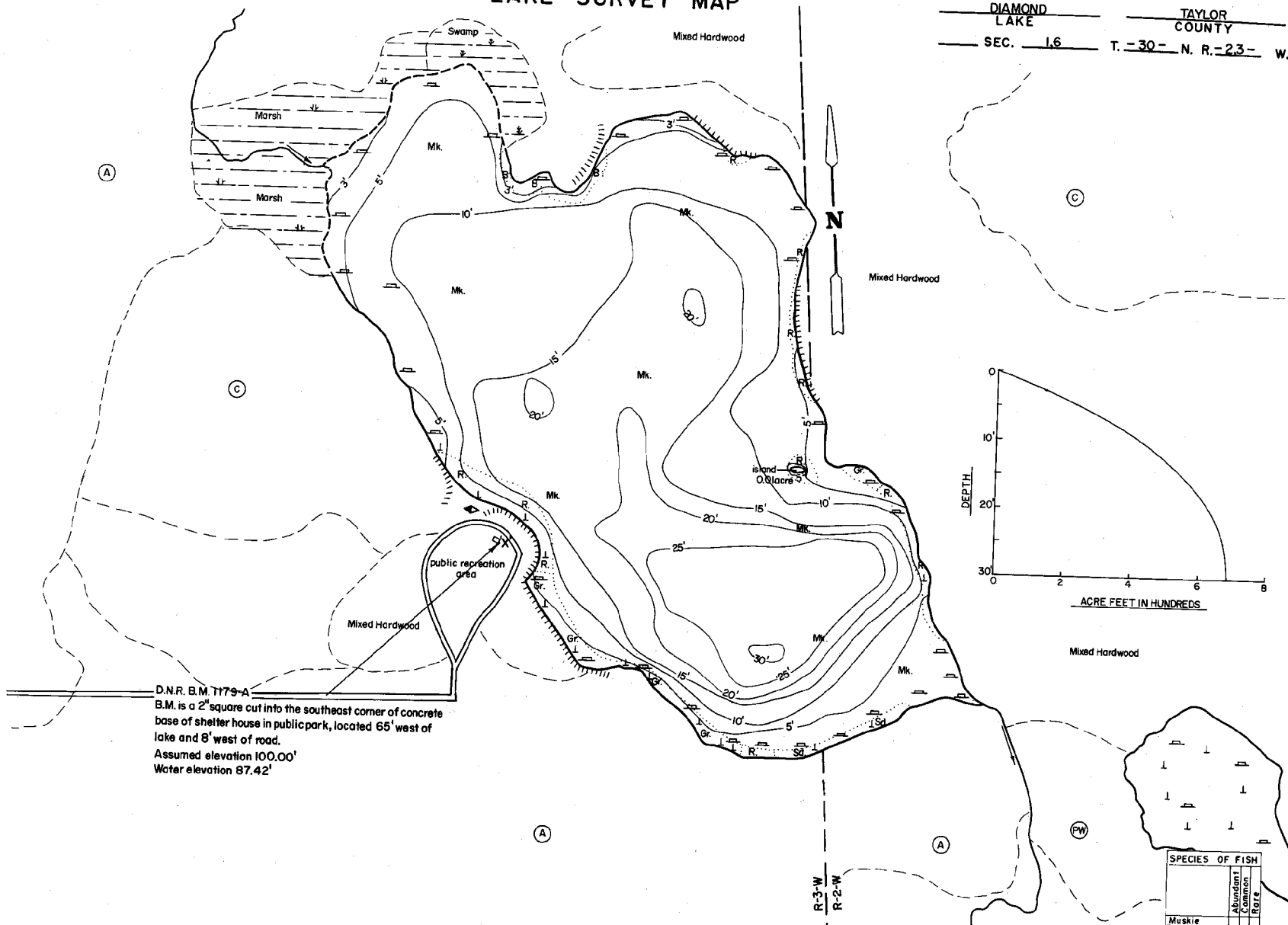

 SEC. 16 T. 30 N. R. 23 W.



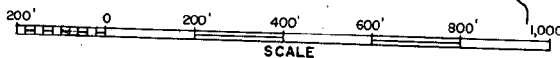
D.N.R. B.M. 7179-A
