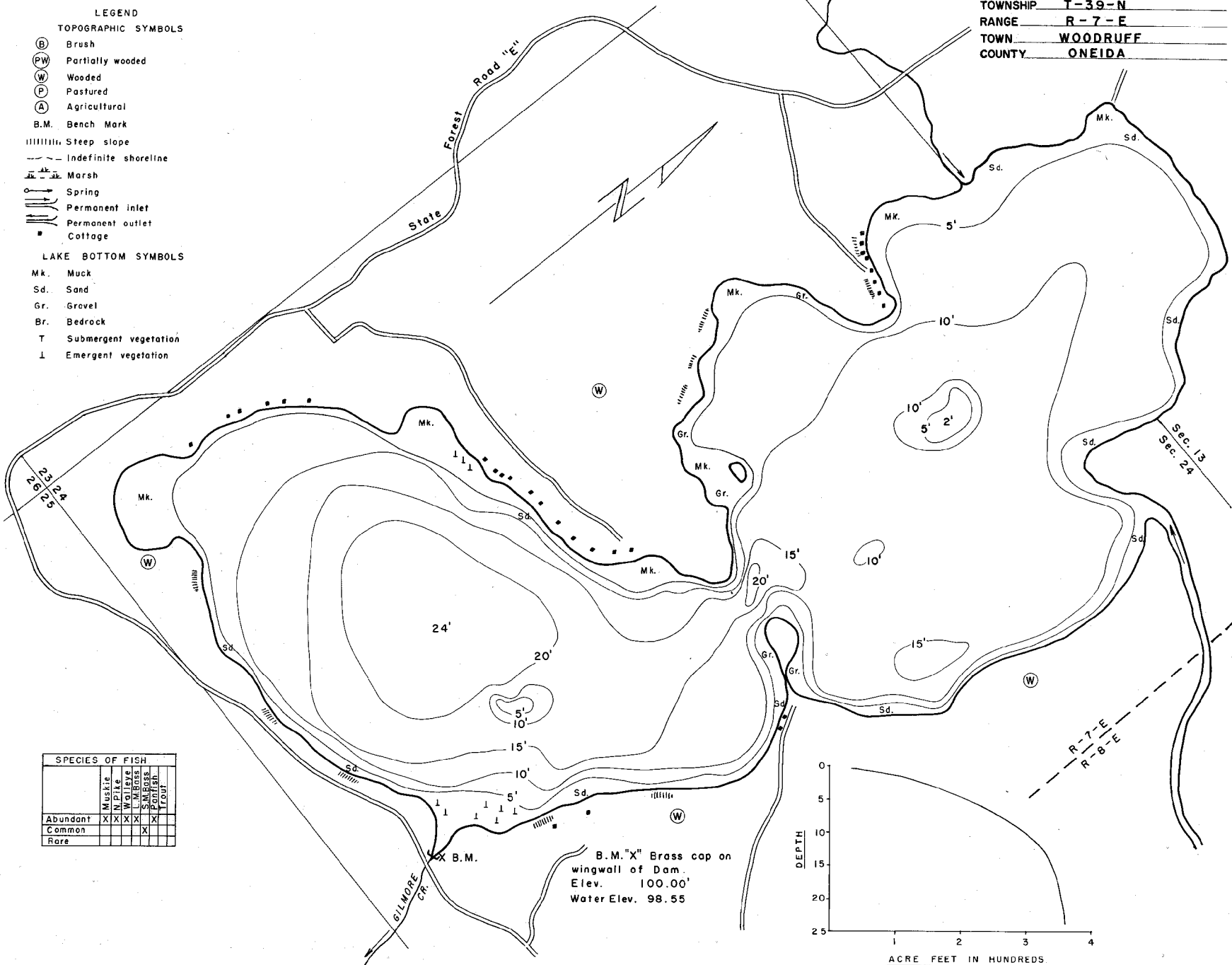

LAKE SURVEY MAP

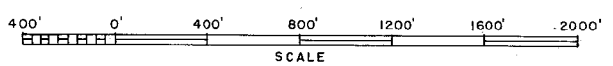
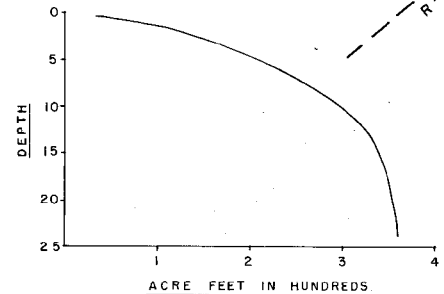
