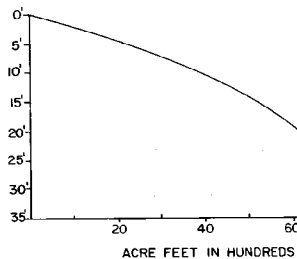

 Water elev. 96.46

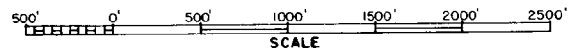
