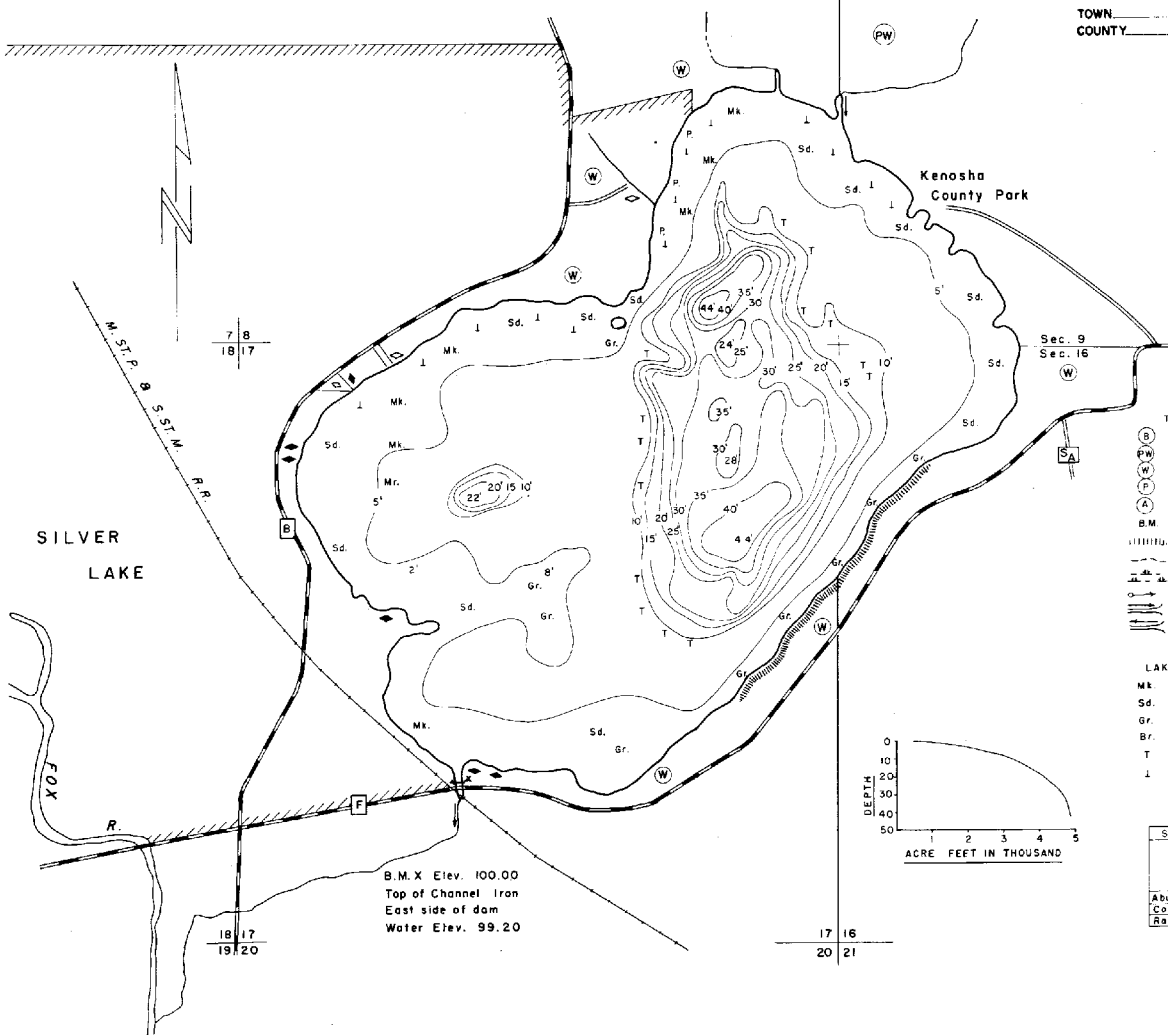

 COUNTY KENOSHA



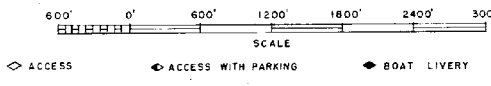
